Scholarship Policy and Application Process

At Advantere School of Management, we are committed to attracting talented, international, and diverse students. To support this commitment, we offer a variety of merit-based scholarships aimed at fostering academic excellence, social impact, and diversity within our student community.

Scholarship Application Process

- 1. **Eligibility:** Scholarships are open to admitted candidates who meet the specific criteria outlined for each scholarship category.
- 2. **Application Submission:** Admitted students must submit a 300-word essay explaining their suitability for the selected scholarship.
- 3. **Deadline:** The scholarship application, along with any required supporting documents, must be submitted within **five (5) days** of receiving admission confirmation.
- 4. **Submission Email:** Essays and required documents should be sent to **admissions@advantere.org**.
- 5. **Additional Documentation:** The Scholarships Committee may request further supporting documents for final evaluation.
- 6. **Decision Notification:** Applicants will be informed of the final decision within a reasonable timeframe.

Scholarships Offered

Multidisciplinary Scholarship

Open to candidates who demonstrate outstanding achievements in their respective fields and have played a unique role in their professional or academic journey.

Jesuit Universities Scholarship

Available for students who have obtained a degree from any Jesuit Higher Education Institution, excluding Advantere's founding partners (Comillas, Deusto, and Georgetown).

International Diversity Scholarship

Aimed at fostering a truly global learning environment, this scholarship is particularly open to students from underrepresented nationalities.

Talent and Equality Scholarship

Granted to candidates with an excellent academic record, proven social achievements, and strong personal merit, who also demonstrate financial need.

Women's Empowerment Scholarship

Designed to support ambitious and proactive women dedicated to making a significant impact in their careers and personal lives. Recipients should serve as role models for younger generations of women.

Changemakers Scholarship

Encouraging students who aspire to drive positive social change, this scholarship supports those who have ideas and initiatives to improve people's lives.
